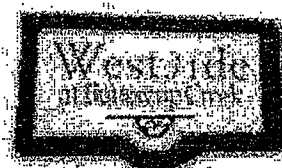


# Westside Pool Rules *Safety First!*

## Emergencies

In case of emergency make two telephone calls:

1. 911 for emergency medical assistance.
2. Contact Goodwin Management Inc. at 512-852-7922 and report incident.

## Entry

3. No Smoking in the Pool Area.
4. Swim at your own risk. Management and Members are not responsible for accidents.
5. Members must use their own key tags to enter the pool enclosure.
6. Members and Guests must sign in at the pool gate when lifeguards are present.
7. Non-members may not enter except as the guest of a member.
8. Someone of at least 16 years of age must accompany children 14 and under when lifeguards are not present.
9. Someone of at least 16 years of age must accompany children 12 and under when lifeguards are present.
10. Pool gate is to be kept closed at all times. Alarm will sound if gate is left open.

## Guests

11. Each guest must sign in, indicating on the sign-in sheet whose guest they are.
12. Resident Children can bring up to 2 guests to the pool.
13. Homeowners (adults) can bring up to 4 guests per household without making a party reservation.

## Regulations

14. Do not swim alone if lifeguards are not present.
15. Lifeguards, security guards or Board Representatives shall enforce pool rules during operating hours.
16. Swimmers must obey the commands of the lifeguards or security guards.
17. No running or jumping within the pool enclosure.
18. No diving or somersaults allowed from the edge of the pool.
19. Dangerous, unreasonable, threatening, or offensive behavior is prohibited.
20. No pets, bicycles, skateboard, or motorized cycles allowed in the pool enclosure.

21. Proper swimwear required. No cutoffs allowed in the pool.
22. No glass containers allowed in pool enclosure.
23. Lifesaving equipment is to be used for emergencies only.
24. Lifeguard stands are for lifeguards only.
25. Children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
26. Fecal contamination is a health emergency. Notify a lifeguard immediately. If a lifeguard is not present, call Goodwin immediately at 512-852-7998 and report the incident. Everyone should leave the water until instructed to return.
27. Children who require a floatation device must swim within arm's reach of someone at least 16 years of age.
28. The baby pool at the Westside Park is for babies and caregivers and not intended for school age children.
29. Loud Music is not allowed.
30. Members are responsible for cleaning up after themselves.
31. HOA pools are intended for resident enjoyment, and may not be used by any resident for commercial gain (i.e. private swim lessons, vending, etc).
32. Pool Furniture is not to be removed or placed in pool.

## Consequences

33. A lifeguard, security guard or Board representative may order a swimmer to take a time out for an infraction of the rules.
34. If the infraction of the pool rules is serious, a lifeguard, security guard or Board representative may order a person to leave the pool enclosure.
35. If a lifeguard's, security guard's or Board representative's order to leave the pool enclosure is disobeyed, lifeguards have instructions to call Cedar Park Police. If police are required to remove an offender, an official complaint will be signed.

## Notice

36. After extended rain, lifeguards may not be present for the entire standard lifeguard hours. Do not drop off unattended children without verifying that lifeguards are present.
37. The lock and security system has the capacity to perform audit traces of which key tags have tagged in and tagged out of pool gates and bathrooms. The system also provides security camera surveillance.
